Baseball state tournament sites set for 2025-28

Locations for the next four years of the IHSAA State Baseball Tournament are set following extensive planning for the upcoming 2025 postseason and beyond.

The split site tournament will head west this summer to Sioux City and Carroll, then return to Cedar Rapids and Carroll from 2026 through at least 2028.

"Thanks to a great team effort, our state baseball tournament will continue to be showcased at first-class facilities with outstanding hosts," IHSAA executive director Tom Keating said.

Sioux City's Lewis & Clark Park will host Class 4A and Class 3A for the 2025 tournament (July 21-25). The 3,800-seat stadium is home to the minor league Sioux City Explorers and will host the IHSAA event on a one-year agreement.

Veterans Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids became a state baseball site in 2024 for the first time since the 1970s and will host Class 4A and Class 3A again as part of a three-year arrangement starting in 2026. MLB scheduling has the Cedar Rapids Kernels playing at home during the IHSAA tournament week in 2025.

Carroll will remain home for Class 2A and Class 1A as part of a four-year agreement, running from 2025-28. Merchants Park resumed hosting in 2021 and is spending this offseason upgrading lighting, dugouts, bleacher seating, and the press box.

"Our sincere appreciation goes out to these communities and ballparks for hosting these tournaments," IHSAA baseball administrator Andy Umthun said.

"We're excited state baseball will visit Sioux City for the first time, and we know returning to Carroll and Cedar Rapids will also provide great experiences for our schools and student-athletes."

The 2025 tournament will mark the first IHSAA team championship to ever be played in Sioux City.

The IHSAA's Board of Control approved the four-year proposal in November, pending coordination with the American Rivers Conference to utilize their MiLB reserved dates in Cedar Rapids. The ARC Presidents Council confirmed the agreement Monday, shifting rights for the 2026 dates from the NCAA Division III conference to the IHSAA.

Tournament dates beyond 2025 pending Unified Calendar approval include: July 20-24, 2026; July 19-23, 2027; July 17-21, 2028.

Madison County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on 26 November 2024 at 9:30 a.m. in the Madison County Annex Lower Level. Chairman Clifton called the meeting to order at 9:33 a.m. with Supervisors Fitch and Stancil present. This meeting was held with a public call-in option. The agenda was reviewed with no conflicts of interest noted. Stancil moved, Fitch seconded, to amend the 19 Nov ARPA work session minutes; Motion passed unanimously. The BOS directed that a resolution be created on the 10 DEC 2024 Regular Meeting to allow for the repairs on the Annex Garage Siding. The BOS also directed that each Boards and Commission create their own policy regarding absences of members and that when we receive applications they are advised of the expectations. Of the four applications for CA, one did not formally apply with our application and the BOS directed that person to be dropped from the interview process. Supervisor Fitch attended a NMRWSA & made progress on the windbreak at the Landfill. Supervisor Stancil attended an MPO meeting, the Middle Mile Webinar (MAE program), and confirmed that the shared liability

agreement (SPV- 111224G) is a 28-E agreement. Supervisor Clifton had an Aging Resource meeting. There was a Mental Health meeting. That State did not ask for presentation for managing the Behavior Health System. Fitch presented the bid for the Annex Garage Roof \$4,720 and Annex Garage Siding \$4,241.00. The BOS directed that a resolution be prepared for getting these done - using LOST funds for the gap. Supervisor Stancil sent 12 RFPs for the Ordinance Update Project giving them until the end of day - 26 NOV 2024.

Fitch moved; Stancil seconded to adjourn the meeting at 10:43 am. Motion carried unanimously.
