

LAW ENFORCEMENT

Winneshiek County
July 12

After law enforcement observed an incident at the Winneshiek County Fair, Robin Kuennen, 44, of Decorah, was charged with providing alcohol to underage individuals. Subsequently a short time later, Kuennen began harassing law enforcement and was charged and arrested with Serious Misdemeanor Assault on a Peace Officer, Simple Misdemeanor Harassment of a Peace Officer and Simple Misdemeanor Interference with Official Acts. Kuennen was transported to the Winneshiek County Jail following the second encounter.

While at the Winneshiek County Fair, deputies found Ethan Folkedahl, 19, of Decorah, in possession of alcohol. When deputies attempted to address the situation, Folkedahl fled on foot. Subsequently, Ethan Folkedahl was charged with Simple Misdemeanor Interference with Official Acts and Possession of Alcohol by a Minor.

Miola Gossman, 50, of Cresco, was arrested at the Winneshiek County Fair and transported to the Winneshiek County Jail for public intoxication.

July 16

Brody Emerson Tieskoetter, 18, of Ossian, was northbound on W42 and fell asleep at 5:30 a.m., according to a report from the Winneshiek County Sheriff's Office. Tieskoetter went into the ditch and struck an embankment.

Fayette County

July 12

At approximately 10 p.m., the Fayette County Sheriff's Office and Iowa State Patrol executed 2 narcotics related search warrants at 220 3rd St. S, Maynard, and 209 N 2nd St., Randalia. During execution, numerous ounces of marijuana, edibles, waxes, and grams of methamphetamine were found and seized. Jason Lynn Burkey, 35, of Oelwein, was arrested and charged with Possession of a Methamphetamine - first offense, Possession of Marijuana - first offense, serious

misdeemeanors, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a simple misdemeanor. Valerie Sue Knospe, 37, of Randalia, was arrested and charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana, a class D Felony, Child Endangerment, an aggravated misdemeanor, Possession of a Controlled Substance - second offense- Marijuana, a serious misdemeanor, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a simple Misdemeanor. William David Troxel, 44, of Randalia, was arrested and charged with Possession With Intent to Deliver Marijuana, Possession of a Controlled Substance - third offense, both D Felonies; Child Endangerment, an aggravated misdemeanor, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a simple misdemeanor. Numerous minors are also being charged with various possession charges. A quarter pound of marijuana was seized during this drug operation.

Jacobsen was elected to the Board of Trustees in November 2012 and began serving in January 2013. Per the WinnMed Board of Trustees bylaws, candidates for Jacobsen's open seat will be reviewed by a Board Governance Committee, and it will be filled by appointment for the remainder of his term.
