ducing the two new staff members, interim CFO, Debbie Miner and administrative assistant, Megan Brown.

Gilbertson added RCH continues to recruit for a permanent CFO. She also touched on four goals. Looking at operating margins, they are looking “fantastic “ and are “re-bounding nicely”; timely utilization is being monitored and she is seeing extra efforts in monitoring labor; supply costs are coming down and working on reducing incident reports is also producing positive results.

Gilbertson also stated retention rates are holding steady at 8.63 and overall financially, clinically and employee wise “we are making some nice changes”.
