Maroons open track season at East Union

The Diagonal boy's track team traveled to Afton on Monday, April 8 to compete in the annual East Union co-ed. There, the Maroons scored 24 team points and placed eighth out of nine scoring teams.

Three Pride of Iowa Conference teams took the top-3 spots in the team race. Lenox won the meet with 139 points while Bedford was the runner-up with 110 points and East Union was third with 81 points.

Five schools were out of the Bluegrass Conference, making the meet a mini-conference event. Moravia was the top Bluegrass Conference team finishing with a fourth-place with a throw of 91-feet,

finish with 60 points.

Four Diagonal athletes competed at the meet. The Maroons top finishes came in the distance events. Both Carter Lumbard and Owen Whittington each had a pair of top-5 finishes in the 1,600-meter and 3,000-meter events.

Lumbard was the runner-up in the 3,200-meter event with a time of 12:17.70 and third in the 1,600-meter event finishing with a time of 5:25.41.

Whittington was third in the 3,200-meter run in 12:18.30 and fourth in the 1,600-meter run with a time of 5:33.77.

In field events, EJ Allee was ninth in the discus

1-inch. Allee placed 11th in the shot put. Allee also placed 19th in the 100-meter dash. Garrett Stephens also collected a top-10 finish in the 800-meter run with an 8th place finish.

Diagonal ran at Moravia on Monday, April 15, and was scheduled to run at Melcher-Dallas the following night, but the meet was canceled due to the weather. The next track meet will be on Monday, April 22nd at Essex.



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
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
