Regular Session Minutes

April 8, 2024

The Diagonal City Council met in regular session on the above date, at the Diagonal Community Building.

Mayor Lester Elliott called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Guests are Zach Gunsolley with DCDC and Jennifer Kellner with the Diagonal Progress.

ROLL CALL-The following members are present: Parrott, Ruby, Norris, and Bentley. O'Kelley is absent.

AGENDA-Motion made by Ruby, second by Bentley to approve the agenda posted April 4th. All ayes: motion carries.

CONSENT AGENDA-Motion made by Norris, second by Ruby to approve the consent agenda. Vote: 4-0 in favor, motion carries. Consent agenda includes a) minutes dated 3-11-24, b) public hearing minutes dated 3-25-24, c) clerk financial reports, d) allow claims submitted.

STREET CLOSURE REQUEST-Zach Gunsolley, representing the Diagonal Community Development Corporation, requests street closure for May 8th event to be held on Broadway Street between 2nd and 3rd streets (1 block) on the east half of that street. The event is called "50845" and will include food trucks, music, and silent auction to name a few activities planned. Parrott motioned to approve closing Broadway for May 8th, second by Ruby. Vote: 4-0 in favor, motion carries.

PUBLIC HEARING-Norris made a motion to approve setting a public hearing date to present the FY25 budget for May 13th at 7:30 at the Diagonal Community Building, second made by Ruby. Vote: 4-0 in favor, motion carries.

BUDGET AMENDMENT-Motion is made by Bentley, second by Ruby to hold a public hearing during the next regular council meeting on 5/13/24 at 7:45 p.m. in the Diagonal Community Building, for a proposed FY24 budget amendment. Vote: 4-0 in favor, motion carries.

FOGLE PARK BOARD RESIGNATION-Mayor has received a letter of resignation from Steve Newton, President of the board. Council and Mayor wish to recognize his years of service, his many hours of donated time to projects, and wishes to also thank Newton for his service.

APPOINTMENTS-Ruby Motions to approve Mayor's appointments for Fogle Lake Board Members to staggered terms at follows; Doug Sobotka-President to a 1 year term, Matt Sobotka-Vice President to a 3 year term, Cathy Schaefer-sec-treasurer to a 2 year term, Jason Smith a member to a 3 year term, Jason Stamps, a member to a 2 year term and appoints Shon O'Kelley to be liaison between the board and the council. Bentley seconds the motion. Vote: 4-0 in favor, motion carries.

DEPARTMENTS- City Superintendent-street superintendent England presents a quote from Manatts to do chip and oil to city streets. England will speak with the county engineer about prep work needed and try to lock in a quote. Clerk estimates maintenance to cost approximately \$175,000. Mayor signs quote.

FOGLE LAKE-street superintendent England also presents council with a quote from Manatts to do single coat of chip

and oil to the campground road. England has previously spoken with park board members about the maintenance needed. Clerk estimates \$30,000 for a single coat of chip and oil. Mayor signs quote.

MAYOR UPDATES-Discussion held on interviews for the position of street superintendent that will be created when England retires in August.
