Notice is given that Dairyland Power Cooperative, La Crosse, Wisconsin, pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 478, has filed a petition with the Iowa Utilities Commission (IUC) for extension of a franchise to maintain and operate an electric transmission line setting forth the following as the maximum voltage, starting points, routes, and termini of the existing line:

The North terminus of this line is an interconnection point with an existing ITC Midwest LLC (ITC) electrical transmission line, located approximately 0.13 mile North of the S¼ corner of Section 11, T93N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa; and, the North endpoint of this line is an existing Dairyland Power Cooperative (DPC) 69,000V nominal voltage, 72,500V maximum voltage, Big Springs Distribution Substation, located in the SE¼-NE¼, Section 18, T93N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa.

The South terminus of this line is an existing ITC Midwest LLC (ITC), Turkey River Transmission Substation, located in the NW¼-NW¼, Section 13, T91N, R2W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa; and, the South endpoint of this line is an existing Dairyland Power Cooperative (DPC) 69,000V nominal voltage, 72,500V maximum voltage, Mederville Distribution Substation, located in the NW¼-NE¼, Section 22, T92N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa.

thence Easterly, on private right of way, in the SE¼-NE¼ of Section 16, T92N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa, a distance of approximately 0.26 mile, to a point approximately 0.01 mile South and 0.01 mile West of the NE corner of said SE¼-NE¼; thence Southerly, on private right of way, along the East line of Section 16, T92N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa, a distance of approximately 0.24 mile, to a point approximately on the E¼ corner of said Section 16; thence easterly, on private right of way, along the West-East Quarter section line of Section 15, T92N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa, a distance of approximately 0.47 mile, to a point on the Center of said Section 15; thence southerly, on private right of way, along the North-South Quarter section lines of Sections 15 and 22, T92N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa, crossing public road (310th Street), a distance of approximately 0.62 mile, to a point approximately 0.12 mile South of and 0.01 West of the N¼ corner of said Section 22; thence easterly, on private right of way, in the NE¼-NW¼ and the NW¼-NE¼ of Section 22, T92N, R5W, of the 5th P.M., Clayton County, Iowa, crossing public road (Evergreen Road), a distance of approximately 0.01 mile, to a point approximately 0.12 mile South and 0.01 mile East of the N¼ corner of said Section 22.

The total distance of this 69,000V nominal voltage line is approximately 9.75 miles.
