## **Clayton County IT Director Arrested on Child Pornography Charges**


A months-long investigation led to the arrest of a Clermont man after authorities discovered a large collection of child pornography in

his possession. On April 23, 2025, the Fayette County Sheriff's Office executed a search warrant at 76 State Street in Clermont. During the search, investigators seized numerous computers and electronic devices from the residence. The investigation identified 63-year-old Robert William Kurdelmeyer as the individual responsible for the illegal material.
