
Bob Holliday knows the connection with his father’s Dutch “family” is part of a

**JUNE 3, 2025 9:00 A.M.**  
The Jones County Board of Supervisors met in regular session. Present Chairman Schlarmann, Supervisors Hall, Oswald, Swisher, and Zirkelbach. During the public comment period Sherrie Thurston asked about the finish date of the Courthouse bathroom remodel project.  
Moved by Zirkelbach seconded by Hall to approve the minutes of the May 27, 2025 meeting. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Swisher seconded by Oswald to approve claims #2506-0001 through #2506-0097. All aye. Motion carried.  
The Community Services Director and the COO of the MH/DS East Central Region met with the Board to discuss the transition of MH/DS East Central Region to the Disability Access Point. The East Central Region is requesting that the Board of Supervisors agree to an memorandum of understanding regarding the employment of the local MHDS employees.  
The Auditor met with the Board for the various items as noted in the motions below.  
Supervisor Oswald introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Supervisor Hall. On roll call vote: Zirkelbach aye, Hall aye, Swisher aye, Oswald aye, Schlarmann aye, whereupon the Chairman declared the resolution passed and adopted.  
**RESOLUTION TO WITHDRAW FROM MENTAL HEALTH/DISABILITY SERVICES OF THE EAST CENTRAL REGION**  
WHEREAS, Iowa law has changed such that it no longer makes sense for Jones County to participate as a member of the Mental Health/Disability Services of the East Central Region (hereinafter, "Region"); and  
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3.4 (Withdraw from the Region) of the 28E Agreement for Mental Health/Disability Services of the East Central Region, Jones County, Iowa wishes to provide written notice of its intent to withdraw from the Region, effective June 30, 2025; and  
WHEREAS, this resolution and its notice effect is pursuant to the vote on the 27th day of March, 2025, of the Region's Governing Board authorizing counties to withdraw under Section 3.4 after October 1, 2024, but still effective June 30, 2025;  
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED pursuant to Section 5.5, this resolution, approved and authorized by the Jones County Board of Supervisors, shall act as notice by forwarding this resolution to the Region's Governing Board of Jones County's withdraw

from the Region, effective June 30, 2025.  
Moved by Swisher seconded by Oswald to table issuing layoff notices for employees employed under the memorandum of understanding with the Mental Health/ Disability Services of the East Central Region. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Oswald seconded by Zirkelbach to issue a layoff notice to the Community Services Office Coordinator employed under the memorandum of understanding with the Mental/Health/Disability Services of the East Central Region and to eliminate the Community Services Office Coordinator position. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Oswald seconded by Zirkelbach to assign General Assistance departmental duties to the Auditors office. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Hall seconded by Zirkelbach to acknowledge a receipt of a manure management plan from John Sanders for a facility located in Section 31 of Oxford township. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Zirkelbach seconded by Swisher to acknowledge receipt of a manure management plan from Cass Way Farms Inc. for a facility located in Section 18 of Cass township. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Zirkelbach seconded by Hall to authorize the Auditor to sign a contract with Advance Builders Corporation in the amount of \$203,000.00 to replace the Courthouse roof. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Zirkelbach seconded by Oswald to make of record the Treasurer's appointment of Beth Steuri as a Motor Vehicle Deputy starting at \$47,527.92, effective June 9, 2025. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Zirkelbach seconded by Swisher to approve Anamosa Commercial Park Third Addition subdivision plat and titleholder's consent to plat. All aye. Motion carried.  
Moved by Zirkelbach seconded by Swisher to approve the collective bargaining agreement with P.P.M.E. Local 2003 for the period from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2028. All aye. Motion carried.

Resolution to Award Contract ID 53-CO53-096 & To Designate County Engineer to Execute Contract  
WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as "the Board", believes the County Road X31 project, hereafter referred to as "the project" is in the best interest of Jones County, Iowa, and the residents thereof. The project is defined as a RCB Culvert Replacement – Single Box on County Road X31 over Mino Creek; and  
WHEREAS, the Board has sought appropriate professional guidance for the concept and planning for the project and followed the steps as required by the Code of Iowa for notifications, hearings, and bidding/letting; and  
WHEREAS, the Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to

protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health welfare, comfort, and convenience of Jones County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa; and  
IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board to accept the bid from Boomerang Corp. in the amount of \$534,526.90 and awards the associated contract(s) to the same;  
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as provided by law; and  
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Jones County, Iowa, that after receiving the necessary contract documents, including but not limited to, the contractor's bond and certificate of insurance, Derek Snead, P.E., the County Engineer for Jones County, Iowa, be and is hereby designated, authorized, and empowered on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County to execute the contracts in connection with the afore awarded construction project let through the DOT for this county.
