The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, May 27, 2025 with Chairman Alan Yahnke and Member David Henderson present. Member Ron Bride was absent.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by David Henderson and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, May 19, 2025.

The Board met with Pulaski City Clerk, J. L. Stogdill, concerning two nuisance parcels of real estate within Pulaski city limits. The Board tabled this item pending a discussion with the County Attorney.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on blading, rock hauling and ditching work completed by the County crews. He further reported that paving was finished last Friday on the Monterey Road and that shoulder rock would be added this week to finish the project. He also noted that the Amish community had donated \$53,000 towards the purchase of rock this year.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke, and carried unanimously, to approve the utility permit for Rathbun Rural Water Association on Yukon Avenue.

Upon consideration of the Letter of Recommendation from IT Administrator, Megan Clyman, David Henderson made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke, and carried unanimously, to approve the transfer of the County's web hosting services to My Cloud Hosting, under the direction of Sasa Spanovic, who has been involved with the County's website since 2018, at an annual cost of \$1,551.00.
