Motion by Montross, seconded by Meyer to approve the agenda. All aye, motion carried.

Motion by Degen, seconded by Montross to approve minutes for May 9, 2025. All aye, motion carried.
Chair Notes: The board approved handwritten claims paid with warrant numbers 38981 and 39135 – 39138 and claims paid with warrant numbers 38982 – 39134.

Motion by Degen, seconded by Meyer to pass, adopt and approve Temporary No Parking signs in Middle Amana - Resolution 2025-05-16 as follows:

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236, 321.239, 321.255 and 321.354 of the Code of Iowa to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles on streets and highways under their jurisdiction and to place and maintain traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, during special occasions, such as elections or festivals, traffic on K St in Middle Amana is increased, and **WHEREAS**, there is limited shoulder space to park a vehicle on K St, and **WHEREAS**, parking restrictions would ensure safer passage of fire and emergency vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that the following described temporary parking restrictions be established and that "NO PARKING" signs be erected giving notice thereof:

1. On the both sides of K St from the Middle Amana Fire Station then east approximately 350 ft to the intersection of 220th Trail

a. Temporary No Parking Restrictions shall be in effect,
a. Start: May 23-26 and May 30, 2025
b. And go until: June 1, 2025

Motion by Degen, seconded by Montross to approve Kum & Go, LC, FY25(current)Permit dba-name change from Kum & Go to Maverik 5301 – due to re-branding. All aye, motion carried.

Maas joined the meeting at 10:00 a.m. via phone.

Discuss the consideration of an amendment to policies HR 016 & SO 001 – Donation of Sick leave. The board has decided to proceed with updating the donating time off policy, to follow the same donation policy that the State of Iowa uses. The Auditor will contact Ahlers to ask them to proceed with the policy amendments as discussed.
