A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 2nd day of September 2025, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: David Rhodes, Don Seams, James Wiltamuth, Teresa Evans, Kellie Anderson, Dan Capenter, Dillon Davenport, and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance
Lange made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve August 19, 2025, Regular Meeting Minutes, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve August 29, 2025, payroll, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve September 2, 2025, claim set, seconded by Wilson.
No public comments on agenda items.

Lange made a motion to approve the City of Allerton request for abatement of past, current and future taxes, penalties, and special assessments for parcel# 10110A159006, seconded by Wilson.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported the following:

A majority of the road department poured a large concrete patch at the intersection in front of the Mormon Trail School in Humeston.

Contractor is working on 245th Street Bridge and should drive piling soon.

The culvert slipling project has begun and is going very well. There are 5 culverts left to complete as of today.

The culvert crew will finish placing the tanker car on 40th Street south of Hwy 65 when weather permits.

The road crew is still mowing the gravel roadsides, blading, rock hauling, and durapatching on S60 and then on old Hwy 2 West.

Lange made a motion to approve Final Plans for project number FM-C093(104)--55-93, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve Final Plans for project number STP-S-C093(98)--5E-93, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made motion to approve Capital Asset deletion of a 2025 Hitachi Excavator ZX250LC-7 and the Addition of 2025 Hitachi excavator ZX300LC-7H w/48 bucket, seconded by Moore. A 2025 Hitachi excavator was traded in for a value of \$259,966 for a new 2025 Hitachi Excavator valued at \$294,300 for a difference of \$42,734 with Mid Country Machinery with 20-year useful life.

Lange made a motion to approve Capital Asset Addition of 2024 62 Country Clipper Lawnmower w/joystick, seconded by Wilson.

Mower was purchased from Vetter Equipment for \$9,100 with a 5-year useful life.

Wilson made a motion to approve Capital Asset Addition of 2007 International 7500 Dump Truck w/plow, seconded by Moore. This dump truck was purchased from Iowa Department of Transportation for \$18,000 with a 6-year useful life.

Moore introduced Resolution 26-04 (modify County's contribution to employee Health Insurance Premiums)

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has funded 100% of employee health insurance premiums; and
WHEREAS, rising costs require a shared funding model to ensure long-term sustainability; and
WHEREAS, notice was approved, adopted and distributed to all Wayne County Employees who participate in the County Sponsored Health Insurance Plan on January 21, 2025, that employees will be responsible for a portion of the monthly health insurance premium beginning June 1, 2026;

NOW BE IT RESOLVED that effective June 1, 2026, Wayne County, Iowa shall require employees to contribute \$100 of the monthly premium for employee health insurance

coverage, with the remaining amount to be paid by Wayne County, Iowa.

ALSO BE IT RESOLVED that employees who participate in the ISAC Wellness Program by completing a physical with a physician and submitting the physical form to Mercy One and completing the Health Risk Assessment by October 31st each year will continue to receive the wellness incentive that waives the employee contribution.

New employees will be given three months after insurance benefits start to complete the requirements to receive wellness incentives before being responsible for employee contribution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this policy shall apply to all full-time employees enrolled in health insurance benefits with the county.

Wilson made a motion to approve Resolution 26-04, seconded by Lange.

Moore gave the 3rd & Final Reading of Ordinance#204 Amendment Proposal:
IV Permit Procedures:

i) Types of systems to be installed will be determined by the Wayne County Sanitarian and be approved in advance of construction beginning.

j) Types of septic tanks will be determined by the Wayne County Sanitarian with the first preference being a cement tank and must be approved in advance of construction beginning.

If anyone would like to see Full Ordinance#204 along with the amendment, you may stop by the Auditors Office between 8AM-4PM Monday thru Friday.

Lange accepted and approved the 3rd and Findal reading of Ordinance#204 Amendment, seconded by Wilson.

Department Monthly Updates:

Kellie Anderson, Wayne County Development Director reminded everyone of the First Thursday Coffee at her office on September 4th @ 7:30AM. Also, the Chamber is meeting on Tuesday, September 9th @ noon at her office.

David Rhodes, Wayne County Sanitarian reported that Chapter 69 for sewer systems is being reviewed, and the process has begun to approve revisions to Chapter 69 later in September.

Supervisors meetings update:
Wilson attended the 10-15 Transit meeting and nothing to report. Wilson also attended the Iowa State Association of Counties (ISAC) Fall Conference in Des Moines on August 20-22. He reported that he learned a lot and that other supervisors from across the state share in their frustrations relating to legislation mandates.

Lange reported that the Chariton Valley Planning & Development meeting was postponed.

Moore reported that the cemetery mapping/plotting project is going well and moving forward. There is still approximately \$10,000 available for this project. Moore will be attending the Wayne, Ringgold & Decatur (WRD) Landfill meeting along with final Heart of Iowa Mental Health Region meeting later in the month.

Discussion items: Wilson also reported that there is a Disability Access Point located in Decatur County for any Wayne County resident needing assistance.

Public Comments: James Wiltamuth, a former Wayne County Deputy was present to speak his thoughts concerning Sheriff Daviss' demands regarding his FY26 Salary Compensation.
