

The following items

Emmet County will have a contractor start spraying noxious weeds along the county road right-of-way sometime around May 12, 2025.

Residents who do not want their roadside sprayed must complete the No Spray Permit. Signs must conform to the "DO NOT SPRAY" signs available at the Emmet County Engineer's Office (at a cost of \$3) and erect them on their property where spraying should be omitted.

The contractor does not spray directly in front of any rural residence hat is being maintained, so signs are not needed at these locations; nowever, the contractor does spray the ROW directly across from rural residences unless notified otherwise. If you are concerned about spray drift carrying across the road to your residence, you need to post signs on the ROW opposite your residence.

To obtain the signs, the resident must fill out an application which tates that they will control the noxious weeds at the sign locations. Applications should be completed annually.

Sign-up must be done by May 7, 2025 in the Emmet County Engineer's Office. Email afisher@emmetcountyia.gov with questions or for an application.

NOTICE to **LANDOWNERS & OPERATORS**

Each person in possession or control of any lands in Emmet County nfested with noxious weeds shall immediately, or at the proper time, destroy and keep under control such noxious weeds according to the following tables:


Group 1 - by June 5 - Leafy spurge, Hoary cress, Smooth dock, Red orrel, Musk thistle, Buckhorn.

Group 2 - by June 16 - Canada thistle, Russian knapweed, Buckhorn plantain, Wild mustard.

Group 3 - by July 15 - Field bindweed, Wild carrot, Poison hemlock, Multiflora rose, Horsenettle, Sowthistle, Quackgrass, Velvetleaf Puncturevine, Cocklebur, Bull thistle, Tall thistle, Wild sunflower, Teasel, Peppergrass, Shattercane, and all other thistles of the Cirsium or Carduus genus, Purple loosestrife.

You are hereby notified to destroy or cause to be destroyed, and as often as necessary to control the growth, all noxious weeds growing upon your property located within Emmet County, Iowa, on or before the dates fixed for the destruction of each group of noxious weeds as stated herein, and that unless you do destroy or cause the same to be destroyed, the Board of Supervisors of Emmet County, Iowa, will cause said weeds growing upon said lands to be destroyed and the cost thereof to be taxed against said land as provided in Chapter 317.21 of the Code of Iowa and amendments thereto.
