NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC KOSSUTH COUNTY SECONDARY ROAD SNOW REMOVAL

Per Ordinance 3B adopted June 29, 2021:

Paved routes will have the first priority for snow removal, followed by unpaved routes.

The entire width of the road surface may not be completely clear of compacted snow, ice or frost. It is not the policy of Kossuth County to provide "dry" pavement conditions.

Normal snow removal operations will be between 5:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Snow removal equipment may be called off of the road if conditions produce a hazardous working condition. The Kossuth County Secondary Road

Department will assist in emergency situations. The emergency situation should be reported through a 911 dispatcher or the sheriff's department.
