On a motion by Durby and seconded by Jensvold the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for May 20, 2025, Board Meeting and approve the agenda for May 27, 2025. All voted aye. Motion carried. City Staff present was Pam Ahlstrom. Steven moved: Meyer seconded to approve the agenda with the addition of ball diamond. All approved, motion carried. Meyer moved: Price seconded to approve May 5, 2025, council meeting minutes. All approved, motion carried. Steven moved: Meyer seconded to approve payroll, June claims, bank stmts, financial stmts, and tax id reports presented. All approved, motion carried. Steven moved: Price seconded to open the public hearing on the proposal to adopt the Lakota Code of Ordinances 2025 Mayor Pro-tem Janssen opened the public hearing. Public Forum-No Lakota residents were present. Mayor Pro-tem Janssen asked for citizen's opportunity to comment on the proposed Lakota Code of Ordinances. No written or oral objections were received. Price moved: Meyer seconded to close the public hearing. All approved, motion carried. Old Business: Steven reported that the Ambulance had their state inspection and passed. Certification is good until 5/28/2028. Nuisance properties were discussed. New Business: Price moved: Steven seconded to approve the 1st reading and to waive the 2nd and 3rd readings of Ordinance No. 107, An Ordinance adopting the Lakota Municipal Code of Ordinances 2025. Candidates must file their nomination papers with the Auditor's office between Monday, August 25th and Thursday, September 18th at 5pm.
