

## Howard Co. Board of Supervisors

**THE TWENTY-SECOND DAY**

The Board of Supervisors of Howard County, Iowa met in regular session as required by law at the Office of the Howard County Board of Supervisors, Cresco, Iowa on May 19, 2025.

Unless noted in the minutes, all motions were passed unanimously.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe Pisney at 9:00 a.m.

Those present were: Chairman, and Pat Murray. Absent: None.

A motion by Pat Murray and seconded by Dean Eastman to approve the agenda as posted with the addition of Sheriff Rick Busch to be acted upon in a timely manner. Motion passed.

A motion by Dean Eastman and seconded by Pat Murray to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion passed.

Pat Murray attended a Northeast Iowa Behavioral Health meeting in Decorah, Iowa and an Upper Exploreland Regional Planning Commission Revolving Loan Fund meeting in Decorah, Iowa.

A motion by Pat Murray and seconded by Dean Eastman to approve a cigarette permit for Hy-Vee Dollar Fresh Market effective July 1, 2025, thru June 30, 2026. Motion passed.

A motion by Dean Eastman and seconded by Pat Murray to approve Resolution No. 1399-2025, Resolution for Interfund Operating Transfer. ## Cresco City Council

Mayor Fortune called the Cresco City Council meeting to order on May 19, 2025 at 5:30 pm. Council Members Carman, Bouska, Fosaen, McConnell, and Kriener were present. No council members were absent.

Bouska made the motion to approve the consent agenda which included approval of the agenda; claims; minutes from the May 5, 2025 meeting; Alley Closing Permit for the alley south of the Cresco Public Library for the Children's Summer Library program for the Chalk the Walk event on June 4, 2025; Alley Closing Permit for the alley south of the Cresco Public Library for the Children's Summer Library program for the Touch-A-Truck events on June 9, 16, 23, 30, July 7, 14, 21, 28, August 4, 11 2025; Retail Cigarette and Tobacco Permits for: Big Daddy Hideaway Corp. dba Sweeney's Lounge, Howard County Jail, JAGDAMBE, LLC dba Cresco Mart, Casey's General Stores, Inc dba Casey's General Store #2511, Faraway Stores, Inc dba Faraway Store #815; Street Closing Permit for portions of North Elm Street for Ridiculous Day on July 17, 2025; Street Closing Permit for a portion of South Elm Street and the Southside Parking Lot for the Norman Borlaug Harvest Fest August 22- August 24, 2025; Parade Permit for portions of 6th Avenue West, 3rd Street West, and North Elm Street for the Norman Borlaug Harvest Fest Parade on August 23, 2025; Street Closing Permit for a Portion of North Elm Street, 2nd Avenue West, and North and South Park Place for the Norman Borlaug Harvest Fest August 23, 2025. Carman seconded and it passed all ayes.

Public Works Director Brenno reported: (a) will start planting boulevard trees this week; (b) the Age-Related Equipment Project is underway. The digester building will start being built soon; (c) Street Department has been busy filling potholes, tarping and cleaning up trees due to the storms and wind last week; (d) Dirt Worx will return to finish grinding the yard waste pile. There have been four incidents of illegal dumping since May 5th; (e) will be attending a nuisance conference on May 21st with Kriener and Fosaen.

Police Chief Ruroden had nothing to report.

City Clerk Hill reported: (a) last spring yard waste pickup is May 27th and will resume in the fall. Wood chips and mulch are available at the yard waste site free of charge; (b) we sold the old sewer department lawn mower and the 1999 dump truck; (c) City election is November 4th. Nomination petitions can be picked up at the Howard County Courthouse. The May-

oral term is two years and Council Members Ward 2 and at-large are four-year terms. Twenty-five signatures are required and the last day to file is September 18th at 5 pm at the Howard County Auditor's office; Kriener and Bouska will review the antenna lease and rental rates.

McConnell reported the park board met. Fitness Center memberships have increased by 15 memberships this month and four new 24/7 membership. They are increasing their starting pay to attract more lifeguards. They are short about six lifeguards. There have been issues of vandalism in the park bathrooms.

Mayor Fortune asked for comments from the audience and there were none.

Brady Norman provided the Council with an update on the proposed housing development. Several community members and local business owners expressed concerns about the project's location, design, storm water management, and the potential increase in traffic. However, a few individuals and business owners voiced support for the development and the additional housing it would bring to the area.

Fortune noted that the City's only role in the matter is to decide on the water and sewer connections. A formal agreement with Norman will be prepared and brought before the Council for review at the June 2nd meeting.

Bouska made the motion to approve the resolution adopting the Comprehensive Solid Waste Reduction Plan of the City of Cresco. McConnell seconded and it passed all ayes.

McConnell made the motion to approve the resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement for professional services with Erdman Engineering, P.C. Bouska seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska made the motion to set the Public Hearing to amend Chapter 92 Sections 02 and 03, Chapter 99 Section 02, and Chapter 106 section 08 (2) of the City of Cresco Code of Ordinances pertaining to water rates, sewer service charges, and yard waste fees for June 2, 2025. McConnell seconded and it passed all ayes.

Mayor Fortune performed the first reading of the summary of proposed Ordinance No. 524 amending Chapter 92 Sections 02 and 03, Chapter 99 Section 02, and Chapter 106 section 08 (2) of the City of Cresco Code of Ordinances pertaining to water rates, sewer service charges, and yard waste fees of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa. Carman made the motion to approve the first reading. Kriener seconded and it passed all ayes.

Fosaen made the motion to approve the resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an

adoption agreement for a governmental 457(b) plan with Nationwide Financial Services, Inc. Bouska seconded and it passed all ayes.

Carman moved to adjourn the Council Meeting at 6:50 pm. McConnell seconded, and it passed all ayes. The next regular Cresco City Council meeting will be June 2, 2025, at 5:30 pm at Cresco City Hall.
