Remove all existing concrete pavement, granular base and concrete curb and gutter on 7th Street West from Highway 9 to 4th Avenue West. The project will replace the existing 4 inch watermain along the corridor with 8 inch watermain. The existing 8" clay sanitary sewer between Highway 9 and Stock Avenue will be reconstructed with 8" PVC sanitary sewer. The existing storm sewer will also be reconstructed and discharged at a new location

with a stormwater pond.

The street will be reconstructed as a 36 foot wide concrete street from Highway 9 north 500 feet then taper down to a 31 feet wide concrete street to 4th Avenue West. The roadway will include 6 inch thick concrete with integral curb over 10 inches of granular base. New concrete approaches will be constructed at existing driveway lo-cations within the street right-of-way. Side-walk pedestrian ramps will be constructed at all intersections to meet the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The location of the improvements is 7th Street West from Highway 9 to 4th Avenue

You are hereby notified that the final

plat and schedule of assessments against benefited properties within the District de-scribed as the 7th Street West Reconstruction, for the construction of street, water, sanitary sewer, storm sewer and other pub-lic improvements, has been adopted and levied by the Council of the City of Cresco, and that said plat and schedule of assessments has been certified to the County Treasurer of Howard County, Iowa.
