BP Terminals & Pipelines (BP) will begin construction in August 2025 on a section of its Dubuque–Spring Valley pipeline that crosses the Upper Iowa River near Lime Springs, lowa (Lat: 43.4766681, Long: -92.2548249). The project is necessary to protect a shallow segment of pipeline and reduce the risk of future exposure or dam-

age.
To complete the work, temporary aqua dams and in-stream structures will be in-stalled in the river for approximately 1 to 2 weeks. Construction will occur in two phases, with one side of the channel closed pridases, with other side of the challent closed at a time to maintain flow and reduce disruption. During these activities, access through the affected reach will remain feasible for paddlers, kayakers, anglers, and other recreational users on one side of the work area. Users are advised to proceed with caution and follow posted signage.

Warning signs will be posted at the con-

struction zone and the nearest upstream and downstream public access points. Local outfitters and parks will also be notified.

To protect water quality and aquatic life,

BP will implement Best Management Practices such as sediment controls, phased damming, and native vegetation for stabi-lization. A mussel survey and relocation will be conducted before in-stream work, and construction will take place outside the mudpuppy nesting season (April 1–July 31). 
