Showtimes are Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Wednesday at 7 pm with Sunday and Wednesday afternoon matinees at 1 pm.

Lilo & Stitch is a live-action animated remake of Disney's 2002 animated film that tells the story of a lonely human girl named Lilo adopting a dog-like alien named Stitch. Lilo is unaware that Stitch is genetically engineered to be a force of destruction, and is being pursued by aliens and social workers.

Motion Pictures and the run time is 108 minutes. It is rated PG for action, peril, and thematic elements.

Sheffield Native Headlines Surf Ballroom

DES MOINES — Midwestern indie band Dickie, led by singer-songwriter Dick Prall, is set to take the stage at the legendary Surf Ballroom in Clear Lake, Iowa on Friday, June 13. For Prall, a native of nearby Sheffield, the performance marks a meaningful homecoming at one of Iowa's most storied music venues.

The Surf Ballroom, known for its rich history and enduring role in American music lore, provides

a fitting backdrop for Dickie's cinematic, lyrically-driven sound. Prall, whose roots run deep in the north-central Iowa soil, returns with a band that has earned praise for its dynamic live performances and emotional storytelling.

Located in Clear Lake, Iowa, the Surf Ballroom is a National Historic Landmark best known as the final performance venue for Buddy Holly, Ritchie Valens, and J.P. "The Big Bopper" Richardson. It remains a cherished venue for artists across generations and genres.
