What's At The Windsor

Thunderbolts* will show at the Windsor Theatre starting Friday, June 6 through Thursday, June 12.

Showtimes are Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday and Thursday at 7 pm with Sunday and Wednesday afternoon matinees at 1 pm.

Please note that Wednesday matinees have been added now that school is out for the summer.

Thunderbolts is distributed by Walt Disney Studios Motion Pictures and the run time is 126 minutes. It is rated PG-13 for strong violence, language, thematic elements, and some suggestive and drug references.

Parents need to know that Thunderbolts* is a funny, touching Marvel Cinematic Universe movie about a group of antiheroes (Florence Pugh, Sebastian Stan, David Harbour, and more) who team up to save the day.

There's lots of action violence: fighting, punching, kicking, martial arts, hits with hard objects, guns and shooting (a child is shot at one point), explosions, crashes, and characters being thrown across rooms, choked, slammed against walls, impaled, and zapped with electric jolts.

There are mentions of domestic abuse, and characters also talk about depression and feeling alone. Language includes several uses of "s--t," "a-hole," "goddamn," "Jesus Christ" (as exclamation), "bitch," "d--k," "ass," and more.

A character talks about being addicted to meth, and another mentions drinking to ease her pain; a flash-

back shows empty vodka bottles. Ultimately, the movie has a powerful message about dealing with trauma and mental illness through empathy; it shows the importance of making real connections with others.

Common Sense Media states Thunderbolts* is for age 13+ and gives it 4 of 5 stars. Rotten Tomatoes audiences scored it at 93%.

Regular movie ticket prices are \$6 for adults, \$4 for youth aged 16 and under. Seniors aged 60 and over are \$4 each on Sunday. All tickets are \$4 on Thursdays.
