How To Train Your Dragon continues for a second week at the Windsor Theatre through Thursday, June 26. Showtimes are Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday and Thursday at 7 pm with Sunday and afternoon matinee at 1 pm. Please note there will be no Wednesday afternoon matinee on June 24.

How To Train Your Dragon is distributed by Universal Pictures and the run time is 125 minutes. It is rated PG due to sequences of intense action and peril.

On the rugged isle of Berk, a Viking boy named Hiccup defies centuries of tradition by befriendng a dragon named Toothless. However, when an ancient threat emerges that endangers both species, Hiccup's friendship with Toothless becomes the key to forging a new future. Together, they

must navigate the delicate path toward peace, soaring beyond the boundaries of their worlds and redefining what it means to be a hero and a leader.

This live-action remake of How to Train Your Dragon is a good movie, particularly for fans of the original animated film. It's praised for being a faithful adaptation that honors the source material while also adding its own unique touches and emotional depth.

Rotten Tomatoes' Popcornmeter verified audience gives it a 98% and a 4.8 out of 5 rating.

IMDb (Internet Movie Database) gives it a 8.1/10 rating.

Common Sense Media gives it 4 out of 5 stars for age 9+.
