covered they could go as close as 50 feet away from the existing tile.

Wright County has the most possible land mass that will be tested so the other counties involved have been allowing them to take the lead in what they want the new boundaries

The 250 feet limit will be kept for bridges but will be reduced for surrounding tile. The testing will only be done on gravel roads and will not be in fields.

"I am comfortable with the 50 feet. We had the plate set up over the top of a tile that was only buried 18 inches deep and we didn't see any immediate damage from the tile," Loots said.
