DEFINITIONS

- Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) – The highest level of a contaminant that is allowed in drinking water. MCLs are set as close to the MCLGs as feasible using the best available treatment technology.
- Maximum Contaminant Level Goal (MCLG) – The level of a contaminant in drinking water below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MCLGs allow for a margin of safety.
- ppb -- parts per billion.
- ppm -- parts per million.
- pCi/L -- picocuries per liter
- N/A – Not applicable
- ND – Not detected
- RAA – Running Annual Average
- Treatment Technique (TT) – A required process intended to reduce the level of a contaminant in drinking water.
- Action Level (AL) – The concentration of a contaminant which, if exceeded, triggers treatment or other requirements which a water system must follow.
- Maximum Residual Disinfectant Level Goal (MRDLG) - The level of a drinking water disinfectant below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MRDLGs do not reflect the benefits of the use of disinfectants to control microbial contaminants.
- Maximum Residual Disinfectant Level (MRDL) - The highest level of a disinfectant allowed in drinking water. There is convincing evidence that addition of a disinfectant is necessary for control of microbial contaminants.
- SGL – Single Sample Result
- RTCR – Revised Total Coliform Rule

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Drinking water, including bottled water, may reasonably be expected to contain at least small amounts of some contaminants. SOURCE WATER ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

This water supply obtains its water from the limestone and dolomite of the Mississippian-Devonian-Ordovician (abv St Peter) aquifer. The Mississippian-Devonian-Ordovician (abv St Peter) aquifer was determined to be slightly susceptible to contamination because the characteristics of the aquifer and overlying materials provide moderate protection from contaminants at the land surface. The Mississippian-Devonian-Ordovician (abv St Peter) well will be slightly susceptible to surface contaminants such as leaking underground storage tanks, contaminant spills, and excess fertilizer application. RESOLUTION 2025-01

A Resolution Approving and Adopting a Revenue Purpose Statement for Expenditure of Fee Revenues from Proposed Electric and Natural Gas Franchise Fees

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dakota City, Iowa, has chosen to establish utility franchise fees for the sale and distribution of electricity and natural gas within the city limits of the City of Dakota City, and

WHEREAS, the City of Dakota City intends to hold a public hearing on proposed ordinances granting an electric and natural gas franchisees in the City to establish franchise fees on sales and distribution services of electricity and natural gas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 364.2, subsection (4)(f) of the Code of Iowa, the City has prepared a Revenue Purpose Statement outlining the purposes for which the City shall use electric and natural gas franchise fee revenues that will be received if the proposed ordinance is adopted.
