To ADD PUBLIC NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS, AND REORGANIZE THE ORDINANCE The Woodbury County Board of Supervisors will hold the said public hearings to discuss the potential inclusion of nuclear energy facilities, nuclear waste storage, and/or related uses as land use options in the Woodbury County Zoning Ordinance. The hearings will address various aspects of permitting these facilities, including and not limited to nuclear energy generation, modular nuclear energy systems, nuclear waste storage, and other related nuclear technologies. The Board of Supervisors will consider options such as amending the Land Use Summary Table of Allowed Uses (Section 3.03.4) to designate nuclear energy facilities, nuclear waste storage and/or related uses as either allowed or conditional uses in specific zoning districts such as the General Industrial (GI) Zoning District and prohibitions in others within Woodbury County. It will also address the public notification requirements including and not limited to appropriate notification distances for nuclear related public meetings and hearings. Additionally, the discussions may include amendments to add new sections related to nuclear energy facilities and nuclear waste storage and/or related uses, add and/or update definitions, renumber articles, sections, and pages, and/or reorganize the content of the Zoning Ordinance as necessary. The goal of the hearings is to gather public input and determine the appropriate ways to address the potential inclusion of nuclear-related land uses in the Woodbury County. *(#396792)*
