Minden City Council Special Proceedings

March 25, 2025
Special session of the Minden City Council was called to order by Mayor Zimmerman at 6:00pm on above date.

Present: J. Schneckloth, T. Schneckloth, Wohlhuter, Murley, Boden. Absent: None Also attending: Jake Nelson, Kevin Brich & Bill Cook
Motion by T. Schneckloth, second by Murley to approve the agenda. M.C. 5-0

Mayor Zimmerman opened the public hearing at 6:03pm to discuss the Proposed Property Tax Levy for Fiscal Year July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2026. Bill Cook asked the council what expenses the city had after the tornado. The council explained a new water treatment plant will have to be built, a new lift station and the damages to the city buildings will have to be repaired. Kevin Brich asked if the city was looking to repair alleys. The council said that alleys are always an area of concern but because of the tornado no major repairs will be made this fiscal year. The city staff will continue to grade and rock the alleys as needed. Mayor Zimmerman closed the public hearing.
