Nolte, Cornman & Johnson P.C., released an audit report on Sibley-Ochevedan Community School District in Sibley, IA.

• Financial Highlights

The District's revenues totaled \$12,214,886 for the year ended June 30, 2024, a 1.23% increase from the prior year. Expenses for District operations for the year ended June 30, 2024 totaled \$11,960,622 a 5.14% increase from the prior year. The increase in total revenues was due in part to increases in revenues from income surtax and unrestricted investment earnings. The increase in total expenses occurred primarily in the instruction function.

Audit Findings

Nolte, Corman & Johnson P.C. reported three findings found on pages 67 to 70

of this report. The findings address issues related to a lack of segregation of duties, the certified budget and questionable expenditures. Nolte, Cornman & Johnson provided the District with recommendations to address each of the findings.

Two of the three findings discussed above are repeated from the prior year. The Community School District's Board of Education has a fiduciary responsibility to provide oversight of the Community School District's operations and financial transactions. Oversight is typically defined as the "watchful and responsible care" a governing body exercises in its fiduciary capacity.


