

Generals dominate Gehlen Catholic

The Generals took the Gehlen Catholic Jays to the woodshed last Friday night and gave them the once over. Well, maybe a third or fourth time over when Sibley-Ocheyedan played their home opener. There were fireworks in September when the Generals outscored the Jays 35-0 in the second half enroute to a 49-14 thrashing. The win boosted the Generals to 1-1 on the season and 1-0 in district play.

The Generals scored on their first possession of the game, needing just 3:14 and seven plays to breach the goal line. Dawson Kreykes capped the 90-yard drive, sprinting the final 15 yards to the end zone. Dougla Macias split the upright on the extra point attempt to give the Generals a 7-0 lead with 3:56 remaining in the quarter. That lead held until there was 1:52 left in the quarter when the Jays pulled off a pick six and kicked the PAT, tying the game at 7-7.

The Jays actually led for a bit in the second quarter. They scored on a three-yard run with

9:59 to play in the half. With the PAT, the visitors led 14-7. S-O answered with 1:18 to play in the half. Hunter Kauffman scrambled seven yards for the score. Macias tied the game at 14-14 with the PAT.

From there it was all S-O. The defense kept the Jays out of the end zone for the entire second half while the offense scored early and often to secure the victory.

Kauffman scored on a three-yard run with 7:43 to play in the third. Macias, who was perfect on the night, booted the extra point for a 21-14 advantage. About 90 seconds later, Kyler Elser scored when he recovered an errant Gehlen snap on the end zone. With Macias staying true, the Generals boosted the score to 28-14.

S-O did not score again until the 11:55 mark in the fourth quarter when Kauffman hit Kreykes on a 16-yard pass. Macias' PAT was good, pushing the lead to 35-14. Kauffman and Tate Marco hooked up for a 14-yard touchdown. Macias pushed the lead to 42-14 with

4:03 to play.

The second string also got a shot to show their stuff and that they did. Levi Sayler scrambled for a seven-yard score. Macias pushed the score to 49-14.

Sayler recovered a Gehlen fumble with 55 seconds on the clock then on the ensuring play took a knee to end the game.

S-O dominated the game. They finished the night with 25 first downs, passed for 175 yards and rushed for an additional 202. Meanwhile Gehlen had 10 first downs, 116 rushing

yards and had -8 in their passing game. S-O converted four of eight third down plays and two of three on fourth down.

Kauffman completed 12 of 24 passes for 175 yards and three touchdowns, Tanner Gruis pulled in four balls for 67 yards. Kreykes caught two passes for 65 yards and two touchdowns. Tristen Wingate caught three passes for 25 yards. Marco one touchdown pass for 14 yards and Luke Heilman one for 14 yards.

A balanced rushing attack was led by Kauffman, who

tallied 66 yards on 13 carries. Gavin Hensch picked up 61 yards on eight carries. Wingate gained 24 yards on six carries; Sayler 24 yards on seven carries; Jaxon Pedley 17 yards on five carries and Gabe Bevers 10 yards on two carries.

Elser had a big night on the defensive side of the ball, recording a team-high nine tackles. Wingate, Pedley, Aiden Beyer, and Luke Heilman each registered five stops. Marco, and Gavin Stanton each logged four tackles.

Hensch returned three Gehlen kickoffs for 63 yards. Kauffman punted once for 38 yards.

Macias kicked off seven times for 272 yards, or an average of 38.86 per kick. Damian Cruz kicked off once for 28 yards.

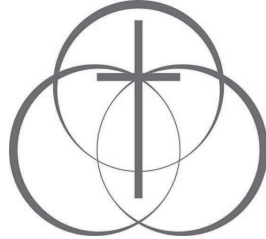
