PANTRY DONATIONS
All items donated to the site pantry are distributed through the site pantry only.
First come, first serve basis.
HOURS: 1st, 2nd, 4th, and 5th Thursday of each month—2:30 pm – 5:30 pm
Donations are welcome, items listed below:
January Baking items: flour, cane sugar, cake mixes, baking soda/powder, brown sugar
February Laundry/Kitchen items: detergent, bleach, dryer sheets, fabric softener, dish soap
March Beverages; coffee, tea, juices, hot chocolate
April Breakfast items: Baking/pancake mix, syrup, cereal, cereal bars, jelly, etc.
May Paper products: toilet paper, paper towel, garbage bags, napkins
June Personal Care items: soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, shampoo
July Condiments: ketchup, mustard, pickles, mayo, salt/pepper Puddings/Jello
August Baking items: flour, cane sugar, cake mixes, baking soda/powder, brown sugar
September Laundry/Kitchen items: detergent, bleach, dryer sheets, fabric softener, dish soap
October Pasta: macaroni, mac & cheese, spaghetti and other related items
November Soups and stew/Crackers
December Breakfast items: Baking/pancake mix, syrup, cereal, cereal bars, jelly, etc.
Any items are welcomed any month but these are suggestions from the site pantry.
Please check the expiration dates on items because we can not give them out once they are expired. This will help our volunteers.

Healthy Feet Clinics

Sac County Health Services wishes to inform area residents of upcoming foot care clinics in several communities during July 2025. Fee is \$45. Clinics are as follows:

The purpose behind the program is to provide skilled foot care to people who may have problems performing this care themselves due to visual or other physical limitations. One of the main goals of this service is to reduce preventable foot health problems. While at the clinic, an RN/LPN will perform the following: an examination of the feet to determine health conditions which may contribute to foot problems; soak the feet, clean, trim and file toenails, provide cuticle cares, and lotion the feet.
People with foot problems such as corns, calluses, and ingrown nails will be referred to their physician or podiatrist. Pre-registration is requested to avoid a long wait for services. To set up an appointment at the "Healthy Feet" Clinic of your choice, please call Sac County Health Services at (712) 662-4785 no later than 10:00 a.m. on the day the clinic is scheduled.
