# Apple Advises iPhone Users To Delete Commonly Used App

Apple has warned iPhone users to delete a commonly used app immediately.

A video titled 'Privacy on iPhone | Flock, which parodies the Alfred Hitchcock film The Birds, doesn't specifically mention Google Chrome by name, but shows how browser information isn't actually hidden from trackers. "Flock" is suspected to be a reference to Google's initial tracking cookie replacement plan, Federated Learning of Cohorts (FLoC), which is described by the company as being "a new way for advertisers and sites to show relevant ads without tracking individuals across the web.'

The Apple video shows

iPhone users being followed by surveillance cameras while web browsing before the cameras explode after the user opts to instead use Safari, the web browser developed by Apple Inc.

The initially released nine months ago, has gained traction after Google announced on Tuesday (April 22) that it wouldn't remove third-party cookies in its Chrome web browser despite promising to do so previously. Apple promoted Safari as a "browser that's actually private" while Chrome allows websites and advertisers to track web browsing activity, leading to personalized ads, as well as a multi-billion-dollar

revenue stream for Goo-

Google previously said it intended to get rid of third-party cookies and develop a new method for targeted ads while focusing on user privachanged hut course after opting to "maintain our current approach to offering users third-parcookie choice in Chrome."

# Iowa Gov. Cites Executive Privilege In Lawsuit Over **Records Request**

Governor Kim Reynolds is suing the Des Moines Register over the paper's public records request for email conversations among the governor's staff and a West Des Moines city councilwoman who is president and CEO of Lutheran Social Services in Iowa who is named in the lawsuit.

Reynolds said her lawsuit is a move to protect the use of executive privilege for "all Iowa governors past, present and

lawsuit, the governor's office provided over 800 pages of documents to The Register, but withheld four documents "containing candid private advice and counsel from her most senior advisors." The lawsuit reveals the newspaper had asked for emails with and about the head of Lutheran Social Services in Iowa. It indicates The Register gave the governor's office a deadline of today, April 25, to produce the four documents.

A spokesman for the governor said Reynolds is confident the judicial branch will recognize 'governors have a constitutional executive privilege in Iowa to receive confidential communications and work product from their closest advisors."

A spokesperson for Gannett, declined to comment on pending litigation.
