Noteboom explained. "To cross boundaries even small towns get caught up in, and sit together and enjoy a holiday meal."

The COVID-19 pandemic forced the event to pause in 2020 and 2021. It returned in 2022 but took another break in 2024 as a leadership team member faced mounting health concerns. The break allowed for the opportunity to take a step back and see how best to move forward, involving more community members in the meal's planning and serving.

This year marks a new chapter, with several Orange City churches partnering to host the event and sharing responsibilities and ownership to ensure the meal remains a fixture for years to come. Living Water's founding team remains involved, but the structure now includes multiple congregations united around a common mission.

While the meal has always had community at its heart, this new model gives it a stronger foundation. With churches working together, sharing the work and broadening the reach, it never becomes too much for one person.

The free meal will take place on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 27, from 11 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at First Reformed Church in Orange City.

The meal will consist of turkey, stuffing, mashed potatoes, corn, beans, rolls, and pie for dessert. Community members can call ahead and reserve a to-go meal or arrange for a meal delivery for those unable to attend in person.

Continuing to serve food insecurity needs in the area, the Thanksgiving commUNITY meal will also serve as a place to collect non-perishable items for the Orange City Food Pantry. The Thanksgiving Day meal is free, but a collection will be available for food items and donations to the area ministerial association as they work to continue to bring this meal to the community for years to come.

Organizers envision the CommUNITY Meal rotating among different church locations in future years, with a core planning team coordinating behind the scenes. By sharing hosting duties, the hope is to keep the meal vibrant and rooted in community support rather than relying on a single congregation.

"This meal has always been about more than food," Noteboom said. "It's about gathering, belonging, and finding common ground. **MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
SEPTEMBER 30, 2025**
The Board of Supervisors (BOS) of Sioux County, IA, met at 9:00 AM with chairperson Jerry Mullenburg presiding. The members present were Mullenburg, Craig Hofzyer, John Degen, Dan Altena & Carl Vande Weerd.
Agenda for the 09/30/25 meeting submitted. Motion to approve by Hofzyer supported by Degen. Unanimous.
Minutes for the 09/16/25 meeting presented. Motion to approve by Vande Weerd supported by Altena. Unanimous.
Ryan Dokter and Teri Bos, from Community Health Partners (CHP), present Resolution 2025-44 Rabies Policy. The policy, as drafted by the Iowa County Board of Health (BOH), sets procedures for Sioux County pursuant to Iowa Code Section 137.104(b)(2). Motion to approve by Hofzyer supported by Degen. Voice votes (all yea).
Kaylee Gibson and Dave Nehring, representing Summit Carbon Solutions (SCS) give an update on carbon pipelines and present on SCS open houses, SCS community and landowner partnership programs and how SCS will drive economic growth. General discussions regarding pipeline maps, voluntary easement participation percentages and timelines are held. There remain many unknowns to all parties regarding carbon pipelines.
Dan Zomermaand, County Treasurer present Resolution 2025-46 regarding Tax Suspension (Montgomery). General discussion was held on how property tax suspension works in Iowa. Motion to approve by Altena supported by Hofzyer (all yea).
Supervisor Altena notes upcoming BOS tour of Family Crisis Center (FCC) and the idea of room naming. Sioux County supports FCC for services provided and does not donate. A room will not be allowed for naming by Sioux County.
Tom Kunstle, County Attorney, reviews the idea of using LG Abatement/Opioid fund dollars for handheld narcotics analyzers as discussed at the 09/16/25 BOS meeting for Sheriff Van Voorst and whether that meets the usage requirements specified for that fund. Further discussions between Kunstle and Van Voorst are required.
Joel Sikken, County Engineer, notes an upcoming meeting with himself, a county clerk's department representative and the Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) to discuss possible safety improvements at the highway 18 & 75 intersection. This was a discussion item at the 09/16/25 BOS meeting. Updates on the hiring process of an Assistant to the Engineer or Engineering Technician to replace retiring Assistant to the Engineer, K30 and K52 asphalt resurfacing project, B40 shoulder widening and ditch grading, potential land purchase for the Boyden shop, receipt of new All-Wheel Drive Motor Grader, 410th Street bridge repairs over the west branch of the Floyd River and Level B dirt road that has been upgraded to a level A gravel road. A general discussion on a few other secondary roads items was held.
