# ORDINANCE NO 717-25 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SIBLEY, IOWA, BY ADDING TITLE 14: DEBT SETOFF PROGRAM BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIBLEY,

SECTION I. ENACTMENT. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Sibley, lowa, is amended by adding a new title, numbered Title 14, entitled DEBT SETOFF PROGRAM.

SETOFF PROGRAM.

TITLE 14 - DEBT SETOFF PROGRAM

14-1-1: PURPOSE: The purpose of this Chapter is to establish policies and procedures pursuant to lowa Code 421.65, authorizing the City to invoke the setoff provisions contained therein for debts owing the City and for which the City has afforded the debtor the opportunity to contest the debt.

14-1-2: DEBTS SUBJECT TO SETOFF CONSTITUTING "QUALIFYING DEBTS" PURSUANT TO IOWA CODE 421.65: All debts or charges authorized herein by the City of Sibley Code or otherwise set by Resolution approved by the Sibley City Council shall be deemed "qualifying debts" subject to the provisions of lowa Code 421.65, for which the City shall provide those procedures as set out herein Title 14 of the City Code Such "qualifying those procedures as set out herein Title 14 of the City Code. Such "qualifying debts" include, but are not limited to the following: a) Past-due or unpaid utility bills water, sewer, storm water, garbage and

a) Past-due or unpaid utility bills water, sewer, storm water, garbage and recycling services.
b) Unreturned (overdue) or damaged Library materials/equipment.
c) Unreturned or damaged City property/equipment.
d) Past-due or unpaid parking tickets.
e) Past-due or unpaid Park & Recreation program fees, park shelter fees, ball diamond rental fees.
f) Past-due or unpaid sidewalk repair/replacement costs.

Past-due or unpaid sidewalk snow/ice removal invoices.
Past-due or unpaid mowing invoice.
Past-due or unpaid nuisance abatement invoice.

Past-due or unpaid connection fees, permit fees, private water lines, curb box (shut off), water meters.
 Past-due or unpaid false alarm fees.

Past-due or unpaid subdivision/planning fees including engineering fees incurred on behalf of developer/contractor/individual.
 Past-due or unpaid cemetery fees and invoices.
 N) Any debt which is in the form of a liquidated sum due, owing and

Any dept which is in the lorn of a liquidated staff day, stang and payable to the Clerk of the District Court.
 Any other liquidated sum certain, owing and payable to the City of Sibley, lowa, with respect to which the City has afforded the debtor.

14-1-3:PROCEDURE FOR CERTIFICATION TO THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FOR SETOFF: With respect to any debt herein, the City shall provide the debtor fifteen (15) days advance written notice to the debtor's last-known address, affording the debtor a period of fifteen (15) days in which they may file an appeal in writing to the Clerk. Upon receipt of a written request for an appeal on a debt to be submitted to the Setoff Program, the Clerk shall schedule a hearing with the Council for the

Seton Program, the Clerk shall schedule a hearing with the Council for the next regularly scheduled meeting and notify the debtor of the hearing date and time at least five (5) days in advance of the hearing. At the time and date of the hearing, the Council shall hear any evidence brought forth by the debtor and shall examine the City's file regarding the matter. The Council shall make a ruling upon a majority vote of the members in attendance. If the delinquency is upheld by the Council or the debtor has not paid the debt within fifteen (15) days of the date of the notice, the City may certify the delinquency to the lowa Department of Revenue for purposes of collection pursuant to lowa Code 421.65.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, said adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION III. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
