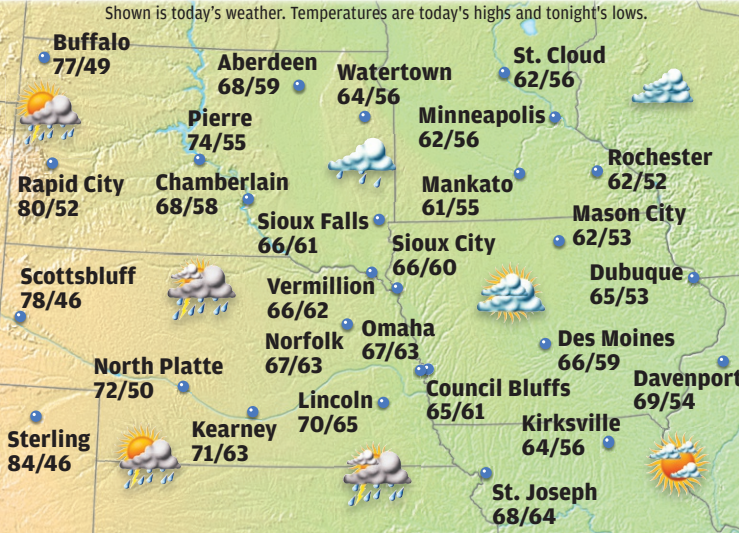

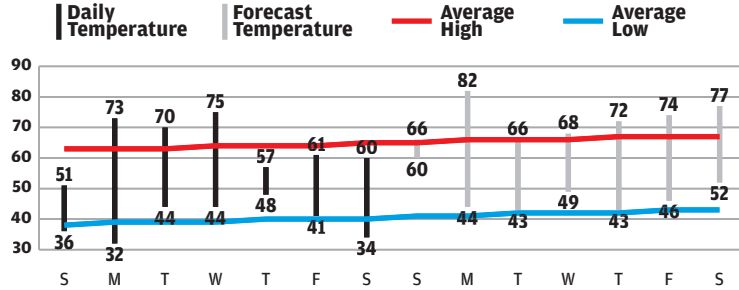

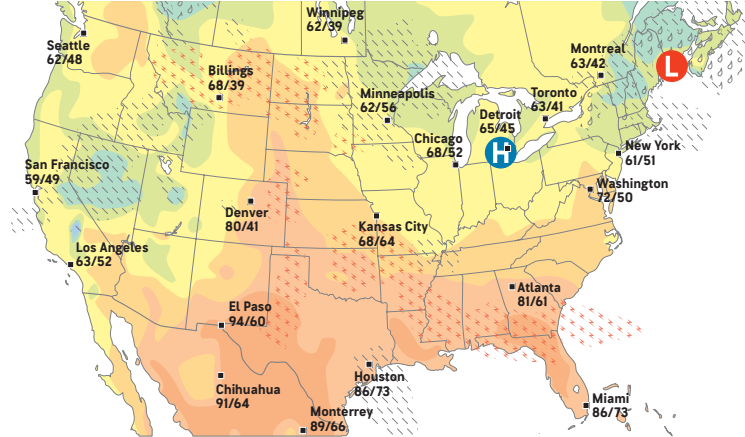

Shown are noon positions of precipitation. Temperature bands are highs for the day.

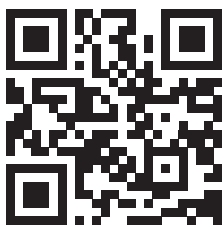
