PASTOR’S COLUMN

Bear (all of) one another’s burdens

“Bear one another’s burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.” So of us read this text from Galatians 6 in worship last Sunday. The “law of Christ,” according to Jesus when asked what was the greatest commandment, included loving others as we love ourselves. Bearing one another’s burdens

is a broad category, and in context, it is actually about restoring people who have brought shame upon themselves. But there is no reason not to expand this “bearing” to helping one another in general, and having compassion on people who feel the burden of judgment by other people. After all, Jesus included these in his teachings about how we treat one another, i.e. love each other.

He also asks us to love our enemies and pray for them. Tough to do, right? These days we tend to make enemies too easily, including but not limited to those whose views differ from ours. Much has been said about that already.

Here’s a question to ponder. If Jesus wants us

to love people whom we identify as enemies, wouldn’t he also want us to love and pray for people we simply do not understand? That’s a big category, at least for me. But today I want to narrow that group to people whose identity or sexuality we do not understand. There has been a lot of debate about this in the church. What would happen if we decided to be curious about people we do not understand instead of judging or dismissing them?

would like to give the remainder of my space today to help people understand what transgender and others in the LGBTQ+ community might ask of us. Not all are asking for approval, according to Lain Vasquez, a “queer youth” as she calls herself. Her essay appeared in June in the Reformed Journal blog. Please prayerfully consider her perspective. I offer it to you, with their permission, as a way of helping us all care for each other, “and so fulfill the law of Christ.”

“My siblings in Christ, please also do your best to use the pronouns people ask you to use and do your best to call people by the name they prefer even if it differs from the name that was given to them at birth.

“I understand that some of you believe that gender variance is best understood as a consequence of the Fall and may feel uncomfortable using feminine pronouns for a person who appears to mostly possess masculine physical traits or using masculine pronouns for a person who appears to mostly possess feminine physical traits.

“You may believe using their preferred pronouns would cause these individuals to mistakenly assume that you have an affirming theological view of gender variance. However, very few folks who are transgender will automatically assume this of people who use the pronouns they prefer. It is much more likely that they will simply feel respected and understood and feel like you genuinely care about their well-being.

“Please understand that people aren’t asking you to use certain pronouns for them as a theological litmus test. The primary reasons why most persons who identify as transgender ask others to use different pronouns for them are because 1) using other pronouns causes them to experience a sense of psychological distress and 2) this exacerbates feelings of gender dysphoria they

are already dealing with. Although you may feel discomfort, using their preferred pronouns puts the person you are addressing at ease. (Gender dysphoria refers to feelings of significant discomfort or distress that a person may experience arising from a persistent or strong sense of mismatch or incongruence between their gender-identity, sex assigned at birth, and/or primary and secondary sex characteristics APA).

“Moreover, not everyone you think is transgender or a certain sex may actually be transgender or that sex. Many cisgender persons are assumed to be transgender or a different sex simply because they don’t look the way others have been socially conditioned to expect or because they have an androgynous appearance. (Cisgender refers to someone whose gender-identity corresponds to their birth sex.)”

“So, please use the preferred pronouns (and names) of everyone you encounter as a way of demonstrating hospitality and compassion.”

There you have it. Some ideas about loving one another to think about. Be at peace, and serve the Lord.
