Ava Campbell Sets PR In 5th Place 1,500 Finish At State

DES MOINES - AC/GC senior Ava Campbell collected a new personal best time in the open 1,500-meter run at last week's Class 1A state track meet. The Chargers senior placed fifth in the event in a time of 4:46.55. That time was also the 28th fastest in the state this year. Campbell also ran in the 800-meter run, where he placed sixth in a time of 2:17.34.

The Chargers also got a season-best time from their sprint medley relay team. The relay team of Nora Langgaard, Meranda Gruber, Cadence Petersen, and Campbell placed fifth in a season-best time of 4:16.03.

The Chargers also had a 17th-place finish in hte 400-meter hurdles from Cadence Petersen. Petersen's time of 1:08.04 was a personal best for the sophomore. Council Bluffs St. Albert won the Class 1A team title with a score of 46 points. The Saintes won the Class 1A state basketball title this past winter. Saint Ansgar was the runner-up team with a score of 40, and Fort Dodge St. Edmond and Nashua-Plainfield tied for third place with 36 points. Martensdale-St. Mary's tied for 18th with 14 points and was the top POI team to place in the 1A team standings.
