cessible. The sessions explain how to give proper notice of a meeting, what belongs on an agenda, when it is legal to go into closed session and what qualifies as a public record. "These laws are really about keeping government open and accessible," said Sara Shonrock, community development specialist with

ISU Extension and Outreach. "People need to know when decisions are being made and how to access public information. That's what builds trust." The Iowa Legislature now requires newly elected or appointed officials to complete training on open meetings and records. That
