Williams said he voted for the bill, but included a note to Governor Kim Reynolds

asking her to use the line item veto on that section.

Williams said the public is charged \$1 if they have a landline and another charge for cell phones to help fund 911 services, and one suggestion was to raise that fee to help with reimbursement, but members of congress decided not to do that.

Audubon County Sheriff Todd Johnson thanked Williams for taking his input on the matter, and said one issue he had with the reimbursement was that he didn't plan for it.

"My budget is already done," Johnson said.

ORDINANCE #247 06.04.25
VACATING STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY
BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Exira, Audubon County, Iowa:
SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance to vacate a certain portion of right-of-way and to authorize its sale to the owners of 512 E. Washington Street. The portion of right-of-way being vacated by this ordinance are the following:
A section of platted alley located between Lot 5 and the South 30 feet of Lot 9, in Block 1, Voss Addition to the City of Exira, Audubon County, Iowa.
SECTION 2. Authorization to Sell. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sell the parcels described in Section 1 to the owner of 512 E. Washington Street for the consideration of \$1.00 and any fees associated with the vacation. In addition to the consideration of the land, the Purchaser must also pay for any surveying or other costs required for the transaction or reimburse the City for such services.
SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions, and motions of the City Council in conflict with this action are hereby repealed.
SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
