CR-B's Leegan Seese Sets New School Record

For one CR-B student who swims with the Carroll Tigers, the season opened in a big way.

Last week, CR-B's Leegan Sease began his senior swimming season with Carroll on December 2 and set a new school record in the process. In the 200-yard individual medley, the previous school record was 2:01.20, and at his first meet of the season, Sease took first place with a school-record time of 1:58.47.

He also placed first in the 100-yard fly with a time of 59.61, was part of the firstplace 200-yard freestyle relay team (1:33.06), and was part of the second-place 400-yard freestyle relay team

Then, Sease competed at the Toreador Relays on December 6. As an individual, he placed second in the 50yard freestyle at 22.02, and first in the 100-yard butterfly at 52.23.
