MAY 5, 2025 • 7:00 P.M.
TEMPLETON CITY HALL

The Templeton City Council met on this fifth day of May 2025 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, Templeton, Iowa. Meeting called to order by Mayor Behrens, and the roll was called showing the following named Council Members present: Tasha Goecke, Dave Ramsey, Joe Irlbeck, Mark Bauer, Cory Drees. Absent: none. Others in attendance: Ken Behrens, Nicci Kathol, Ethan Irlbeck, Nick Romey. Motion made by Goecke, second by Ramsey to approve the agenda. Motion carried. At 7:01 the public hearing for budget amendment #2 open to the public. No comments submitted to city hall prior to meeting and no comments made. Motion made by Ramsey, second by Irlbeck to close public hearing at 7:09. Motion carried. Bauer introduced and moved for adoption of Resolution #2025-9 a Resolution approving the City's Proposed Amendment #2 to FY 24/25 budget, second by Goecke, on roll call, all present voted aye. Bauer introduced and moved for adoption of Resolution #2025-10 a Resolution authorizing the City of Templeton to enter into an agreement with the Templeton Community Betterment Association for use of the city facilities, grounds & street for the annual slow pitch tournament June 2-8, 2025, second by Irlbeck, on roll call, all present voted aye. Bauer introduced and moved for adoption of Resolution #2025-11 a Resolution authorizing the City of Templeton to enter into an agreement with the Good Shepherd Parish for use of the city facilities, grounds & street for the annual street dance July 3, 2025, second by Goecke, on roll call, all present voted aye. Motion by Goecke, seconded by Irlbeck to approve adding Blue Dental 2000 to employee benefits effective July 1, 2025. Motion carried. Bauer introduced third and final reading of Ordinance #97 an ordinance changing the water and sanitary sewer rates and amending the 2021 City of Templeton Code of Ordinances, seconded by Drees, on roll call, all present voted aye. Bauer introduced and moved for adoption of Resolution #2025-12 a Resolution authorizing the city clerk to make the appropriate interfund transfers of sums and record the same in the appropriate manner for FY 2025 for the City of Templeton, second by Drees, on roll call, all present voted aye. Motion by Irlbeck, seconded by Goecke to approve quote from RK's Tree Service for tree removal for FY26. Council discussed attendance at next Carroll County Roundtable. Goecke moved, second by Drees to approve items listed on the Consent Agenda. Minutes dated April 7, 2025, April 21, 2025. Financial Reports, & Claims. Internal review of City financial records and assets. Motion carried. March 2025 Revenue Fund Totals: General Fund-12,829.92, Templeton Center-1,046.45, Historical Society-0.27, Road Use Fund-2,420.63, Employee Benefits Fund-245.81, Local Option Sales Tax-5,645.01, Debt Service Fund-409.58, Water Fund-13,364.12, Sewer Fund-5,858.93, Sewer Sinking Fund-801.66, Fire Truck Fund-5.37= Revenue Grand Total-42,627.75.
