George "Bert" Hillers was born on May 12, 1940, to Christe and Lenore (King) Hillers in Bedford, IA. He grew up in Blockton, IA, where he attended grade school through high school. Bert continued his education at Muscatine Junior College for two years before graduating from Northwest Missouri State in Maryville in 1963 with a Bachelor's degree in Education, majoring in mathematics.

On December 29, 1963, Bert was united in marriage to Judy Brandt at the Lutheran Church in Hooper, NE. He began his teaching career at Park Hill Junior High in Kansas City, MO, where he taught 7th and 8th grade from 1963 to 1965. In 1966, he and Judy moved to Harlan, where Bert taught 9th grade at HCHS until 1969. He then worked at Christensen Auto from 1969 to 1974 before opening Bert's Auto in Harlan, which he owned and operated until his retirement in 2022. Judy passed away on December 13, 1995. The right of free speech is meaningless if no one knows what's really going on.
