The Clearfield City Council met in regular session on Wednesday, January 15, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Protém Chris England. Council members present were: Travis Borcharding, Logan Larsen and Chris England. Absent, Clete Boyer, Greg Beggs and Charles Strassner, Mayor.

A motion by Borcharding was seconded by Larsen to approve the agenda as posted. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Larsen and seconded by Borcharding to approve the minutes for December 18, 2024 as written. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Larsen was seconded by Borcharding to approve the bills submitted for payment. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Larsen, seconded by Borcharding to approve the financial reports for December 2024. All in favor.

Employees and visitors present were: Gordon Still, Public Works; Colleen Larimer, Lenox Times Table; Pam Nickell, City Clerk; Markeeta Baker, Tim Gormally and Matthew Hanson, City Attorney.

STAFF REPORTS--

Public Works (Gordon Still)--The pump suction pipe is scheduled to be replaced at lift station #2 on Tuesday. Allied will be checking the lift station at Jackson Street this week. Gordon will be taking the plow truck to Just Power & Repair to have the starter replaced.

OLD BUSINESS;

Pam Nickell, City Clerk, contacted John Danos, Dorsey & Whitney LLP, in regard to General Obligations Bonds. This information was given to the council for discussion. Decision was tabled due to lack of full council.

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion by Borcharding, seconded by Larsen to approve appointments and committees as recommended by the Mayor. (Attachment to permanent minutes.)

Chris England got bids from Billy Bentley to tear down and clean up two abandoned houses. The cost to clean up 400 Washington Street was \$12,500 and 215 Van Buren was \$7,500. Council agreed the priority at this time is the sewer repairs.

A motion by Larsen was seconded by Borcharding to approve Resolution 2025-01, a resolution appointing Roger Hering for three years, as the one person to serve as Commissioner of the Southern Iowa Regional Housing Authority, representing the City of Clearfield. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Larsen, seconded by Borcharding to schedule the next regular meeting for February 19, 2025. Motion carried 3-0.

A motion by Borcharding, seconded by Larsen to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
