Notice is hereby given that on the 21st day of May, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. a public hearing will be held before the City Council of Clearfield, Iowa, at the Clearfield City Hall, with reference to amending the previous sewer service charge ordinance to as follows:

Each customer shall pay sewer service charges for the use of and for the service supplied by the municipal sanitary sewer system based upon the amount of water consumed as follows:

- 1. 1-2,000 gallons or lesser amount at \$40.00.
- 2. Next 59,000 gallons or lesser amount at \$10.00 per 1,000 gallon.
- 3. All over 60,000 at \$9.50 per 1,000 gallon

A minimum service charge of \$20.00 per month is assessed to all customers, even if no usage. This is necessary to retire the indebtedness, operating and maintenance, and reserve necessary for maintaining the sanitary
