Fire Chief (this was reported by Dave King): details were presented: Fire & Medical calls from the last council meeting:
Fire calls - 2, Medical-5, and Control burns - 1. The training committee is looking into sharing training with neighboring departments. This will help share training costs across all departments. There is never enough money to budget for this. It is getting expensive to have specialized training trailers brought in (smoke trailers, grain bin trailers, forble entry trailers).
