

Indian baseball team drops first three

Gerbracht leads D-NH baseball team past Sumner-Fredericksburg

 DIKE - Gavin Gerbracht went 3-for-3 at the plate with a pair of doubles and was also the winning pitcher Tuesday as the Dike-New Hartford baseball team topped Sumner-Fredericksburg 12-7 in its season opener.

The Wolverines (2-1) also topped Maquoketa Valley 3-2 Friday while dropping a 7-3 game to Union Community Thursday.

Gerbracht threw 4 2/3 innings in the victory over S-F, striking out seven while allowing just two hits. He also scored a run and drove home one. The Wolverines jumped ahead 5-0 after two innings and led 10-0 in the fourth be-

fore Sumner-Fredericksburg found its offensive rhythm. Aiden Walston added three hits for D-NH while Quinn Mills had two hits.

Friday the Wolverines trailed Maquoketa Valley 2-0 after three innings before taking the lead with a three-run fourth. That was enough for Mills on the hill, as he threw a complete game, striking out nine while scattering seven hits. Corbin McCarter led the D-NH offense with a pair of hits.

Dike-New Hartford hosted Wapsie Valley Monday and played at AGWSR Tuesday. It hosts Aplington-Parkersburg tonight (Thursday) and is at the Iowa Falls-Alden tournament Saturday.
