CITY OF GRANDVIEW ANNUAL NOTICE – MOWING OF PROPERTIES (2026)

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grandview, vegetation on properties within the City may not exceed eight (8) inches in height. Properties not mowed in compliance with City ordinance may be mowed by the City or its agents. The cost of mowing shall be \$100 per hour, one-hour minimum, plus a \$100 surcharge, billed to the property owner. Unpaid charges may be assessed to the property and collected as general property taxes. This annual publication serves as notice to property owners. Exception: Properties used to grow agricultural crops that are timely harvested are exempt, except that agricultural crops may not be grown in platted residential subdivisions.
