 The BCLUW Board of Education met in Special Session on Wednesday, May 27, 2026 at 7:00 a.m. in the Media Center at the BCLUW High School. Present on a roll call vote was Board President: Adam Probasco, Vice President: Brent Schipper, Board Members: Alicia Matney, Jill Lutes, Jacey Lehman, and Alan Donaldson. Also present were Superintendent: Ben Petty, Secretary/Treasurer: Leah Woiwood, High School Principal: Josh Tack, High School Guidance Counselor: Kristin Benson, Teacher: Karen Hammers, and three members of the community.
AGENDA: Motion by Lutes, second by Matney to approve the agenda as presented.
 All ayes. Motion carried.
REVIEW STEPS FOR FILLING A BOARD VACANCY AND SELECT METHOD: Superintendent, Ben Petty, shared with the board the form from Iowa Association of School Boards which shows the ways a board vacancy can be filled. The board discussed how they would like to move forward with the process. Motion by Lutes, second by Donaldson to have interested members submit the 2 questions

that will be posted on the districts social media and then plan to come speak to the board at a set time for 3 minutes or less on why they are interested in being on the board. All ayes. Motion carried.
CONSIDERATION OF PLANS FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL USAGE: Mr. Petty discussed with the board his recommendation moving forward with the middle school is to shut the doors. This would save \$6,000 on the property insurance bill as the district could take it from replacement value cost to cash value cost. Mr. Petty also shared with the board the utility costs of gas, electricity, and water for FY25 just at the middle school building as this will also be a saving cost and help our general fund balance. Mike Hayes, building and ground director/transportation director, entered the meeting and informed the board he has received one quote on putting up a few walls to close off the classrooms and that cost was around \$3,600. Mike informed the board there are still many costs involved to keep just a portion of the building running as there are many leaks in the roof and the roof is very old and there is a bat problem in the stage area. The fire alarm system

would also have to be kept up and most likely replaced in the future. Mike informed the board he would use the 5th grade building and bus barn for storage. The board discussed reaching out to the state and county on if there is any economic development that could take place there. The board also discussed if the building is going to be shut down money needs to be set aside to have it demolished in the future. Board all agreed the building can be reduced to cash value on the property insurance.
SUPERINTENDENT COMMENTS: Mr. Petty gave an update on the parent complaint from the last board meeting. After reaching out to legal counsel the issue does not need to be brought back to the board as the admin took care of the situation. Handbooks will be brought to the June meeting to review and update as needed.
ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 a.m.
