GOAT will show for one week at the Windsor Theatre from Friday, March 20, through Thursday, March 26.

Regular showtimes are Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday and Thursday at 7:00 PM, with matinees on Sunday at 1:00 PM and Wednesday at 2:00 PM.

GOAT is a 2026 American animated sports comedy film directed by Tyree Dillihay and produced by Columbia Pictures and Sony Pictures Animation.

A small teenage goat named Will gets a once-in-a-lifetime shot to join the pros and play roarball -- a high-intensity, full-contact sport that's dominated by the fastest, fiercest animals in the world. Ridiculed by his teammates, Will becomes determined to revolutionize the sport and prove that "small can ball!"

Caleb McLaughlin stars as Will Harris, an anthropomorphic (having human characteristics) goat who aspires to become the greatest of all time at a basketball-like sport known as roarball.

Gabrielle Union, Aaron Pierre, Nicola Coughlan, David Harbour, Nick Kroll, Jennifer Lewis, Patton Oswalt, Jelly Roll, Wayne Knight, Jennifer Hudson, Sherry Cola, Eduardo Franco, Andrew Santino and Bobby Lee also star, alongside basketball player Stephen Curry (who

also produced) in his film debut.

Partly inspired by Curry's own career as an expert shooter who is short by league standards, the movie focuses on a "dream big" message and challenges the idea that size matters most in the sport.

Distributed by Sony Pictures Releasing, the film is rated PG for some rude humor and brief mild language, making it generally suitable for children with parental guidance. Running time is 100 minutes.

Parents need to know there are several references to a parent's death (by sickness), and, early on, the poverty that Will experiences. Violence is mostly related to characters' jokes about eating other animals (which may unsettle some kids) and occasional roarball aggression (pushing, falling, breaking ankles) and potentially dangerous arenas. Will is taunted by some of the bigger players, and the dialogue includes a few insults and exclamations like "butt," "dang," "sucks," and "hogwash."

While there's no romance, roarball fans think various players are attractive and propose marriage to one player;

phrases like "thirst trap," "hot," and "snack" are used. Both the voice
