Reminders of Him will show for one week at the Windsor Theatre from Friday, March 27, through Thursday, April 2.

The film adaptation of Colleen Hoover's 2022 novel, *Reminders of Him*, is the second featured title 'Read the Book Before You See the Movie' promotion. To check out a copy of the book, contact the Hampton Public Library.

Regular showtimes are Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday and Thursday at 7:00 PM, with matinees on Sunday at 1:00 PM and Wednesday at 2:00 PM. An additional show has been scheduled for Saturday at 11:00 AM.

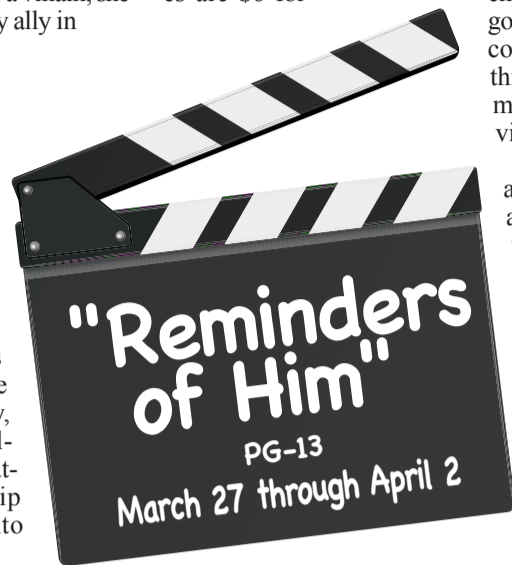
Reminders of Him tells the story of Kenna Rowan, portrayed by Maika Monroe, who returns to her hometown after serving five years in prison for a drunk-driving crash that claimed the life of her boyfriend, Scotty. Determined to rebuild her life, Kenna seeks to reconnect with her young daughter, Diem, now being raised by Scotty's parents, who remain deeply resentful.

As Kenna works to earn forgiveness in a community that views her as a villain, she finds an unlikely ally in Ledger Ward, played by Tyriq Withers. A bar owner and Scotty's best friend, Ledger has helped care for Diem and initially distrusts Kenna. However, as he learns more about her story, the two develop a complicated relationship that grows into romance.

Their connection creates tension with Scotty's family, placing Ledger in a difficult position between loyalty to his late friend and his feelings for Kenna. Directed by Vanessa Caswill, the film explores themes of forgiveness, redemption, and the challenges of rebuilding a life after prison.

Distributed by Universal Pictures, the film is rated PG-13 sexual content, strong language, drug content, some violent content, and brief partial nudity. Running time is

114 minutes.
Regular movie ticket prices are \$6 for



adults and \$4 for youth age 16 and under. Seniors (60 and over) receive a discounted price of \$4 on Sundays. All tickets are \$4 for the Wednesday matinee and the Thursday evening show.

Tickets are available for purchase at the door or online at www.windsortheatre.com. Credit cards are accepted.

The Windsor Theatre offers a variety of gift options for movie lovers. "Windsor Bucks" gift certificates are available in \$5 and \$1 denominations and can be used

for admission or concessions. Popcorn fans can purchase a \$100 Popcorn Card, good for one free large popcorn and a refill each day through March 1, 2027. No movie ticket is required to visit the concession stand.

Movie passes are also available for \$6 for adults and \$4 for youth (16 and under). Frequent moviegoers can save with a Punch Card—25 punches for \$20, with each punch worth \$1 toward admission.

Businesses or individuals can sponsor a movie for \$300 and receive 100 tickets to share, helping support the theatre and bring more people to the movies.
