BOARD OF EDUCATION  
MARCH 16, 2026**

The public hearing on the Instruction Support Levy was called to order by president Mahler at 6:00 PM in the High School Library. No public comments had been heard from the board. Jansma moved to adjourn the public hearing, Wallace seconded; motion carried 5-0. The public hearing adjourned at 6:01 PM.

The public hearing on the proposed 2026-27 school calendar was called to order by president Mahler at 6:01 PM in the High School Library. No public comments had been heard from the board. Leners moved to adjourn the public hearing, Kluver seconded; motion carried 5-0. The public hearing adjourned at 6:02 PM.

The regular meeting was called to order by President Mahler at 6:02 PM at the East Sac County High School. Present were Wallace, Jansma, Leners, Kluver, and Mahler. Also in attendance were Superintendent Hemiller, Principal Tedesco, Principal Halbur, and Vice Principal Spetman.

Wallace moved to approve the agenda as presented, Kluver seconded; motion carried 5-0.

The administrative reports were reviewed. Topics included professional development, the SIAC meeting, High School career day results, and student activities.

The consent items were presented for approval. The consent items included Minutes of the February 16 2026 Regular Meeting, March bills on account of \$346,846.51, updated Board Policies, participation in the Iowa LGRP program, and the AEA Purchasing Agreement. Wallace moved to approve the consent items, Jansma seconded; motion carried 5-0.

A two-year contract with Corn Belt Telephone to provide network services between the Lake View High School and Sac City Elementary was presented to the board for approval. Wallace moved to approve the contract, Kluver seconded; motion carried 5-0.

A quote from Aercor to purchase wireless access points at a total cost of \$86,183.80 was presented to the board for approval. Jansma moved to approve the quote, Leners seconded; motion carried 5-0.

Continued participation in the Instructional Support Levy was presented to the board for approval. Leners moved to approve participation, Wallace seconded; a roll call vote was taken with the following results: Ayes – Wallace, Jansma, Leners, Kluver, Mahler. Motion carried 5-0.

The 2026-27 school calendar was presented to the board for approval. Wallace moved to approve the calendar as it was presented, Jansma seconded; motion carried 5-0.

The following resignations were presented for approval: Lisa Phillips - Secretary, Brianna Pierce - Secretary. The following contracts were presented for approval: Jodi Reese - HS Musical, Susan Groth - MS Student Council, Joselyn Ayala - Teacher, Diego Cristancho - Spanish, Sasha Bumsted - Associate. Contracts for

the 2026-27 school year were presented to the board for approval. These included teachers, coaches, classified support staff, and administration. Sharing agreements between ESC CSD and Ar-We-Va CSD and between ESC and The City of Lake View were also presented for renewal. Wallace moved to approve the personnel items as presented, Leners seconded; motion carried 5-0.

The next regular meeting will be April 20th at 6:00 PM in the high school.

Leners moved to adjourn, Kluver seconded; motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:30 PM.
