## PASTOR'S COLUMN

## Slow to speak

By the time you read this, I will have preached a sermon suggesting that we could all do a better job of staying silent. I'm not sure how it went yet, but I stand by the idea.

We live in an era of nonstop noise, endless voicing of opinions, and constant propaganda. Never before have so many voices had so much access to so many people, and I'm not sure it's going well. Everybody seems exhausted, on edge, angry or scared, and a few seem all of the above. It's not that the issues we face aren't important, exactly the opposite. They are so important that we should take time to think carefully and speak cautiously. Or maybe even consider not speaking at all.

Silence has a longstanding place among Christian virtues. People of faith have long recognized the human ability to damage relationships and neighbors with rash, hasty or harsh words. James (of the Bible) counsels us to "tame our tongues" warning that we can do great evil even with such a small thing. That hasn't changed, except that maybe it's gotten even easier to do. Now we can just type it up and send it, and the people we aim it at don't even need to be

anywhere close to us.

The Scripture challenges us to be silent when we might do damage, when we are being judgmental, when we might offend a brother or sister, when we are tempted to gossip, and when we are angry. And that's just for starters. In a noisy and angry world, full of noisy, angry words, Christians are called to guard what we say and speak carefully. Our algorithms may have us all convinced that people need to hear our opinions, but the Bible teaches otherwise. You can say the right thing, and still be wrong for saying it. As I often tell couples at their weddings, "You can be right, but if you hurt each other proving it, you aren't."

Perhaps the above mentioned James says it best when he instructs, "Brothers and Sisters, everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to become angry." I think we get that backward a lot. Far too often, we are quick to speak, quick to get angry, and slow to listen, which might feel good in the moment, but isn't good for our discipleship or our witness. As I hope I said Sunday in the sermon, "What people need to hear from Christians is not our opinions, but our savior." They need to hear Jesus, and if they don't hear him from us, they certainly aren't likely to hear him from the world. Before we speak or post or whatever else passes for communication in the moment we are in, pause to consider whether what you are about to say needs said, and more importantly, whether it reflects Jesus.

**POPE LEO XIV FACES CRISIS AS A TRADITIONALIST GROUP PLANS BISHOP CONSECRATIONS WITHOUT CONSENT**

VATICAN CITY (AP) — Pope Leo XIV is facing his first major crisis with traditionalist Catholics: A breakaway group attached to the traditional Latin Mass announced plans to consecrate new bishops without papal consent in a threatened revival of schism.

The Swiss-based Society of St. Pius X, which has schools, chapels and seminaries around the world, has been a thorn in the side of the Holy See for four decades, founded in opposition to the modernizing reforms of the 1960s Second Vatican Council.

In 1988, the group's founder, Archbishop Marcel Lefebvre, consecrated four bishops without papal consent, arguing that it was necessary for the survival of the church's tradition. The Vatican promptly excommunicated Lefebvre and the four other bishops, and the group today still has no legal status in the Catholic Church.

But in the decades since that original break with Rome, the group has continued to grow, with branches of priests, nuns and lay Catholics who are attached to the pre-Vatican II traditional Latin Mass.

For the Vatican, papal consent for the consecration of bishops is a fundamental doctrine, guaranteeing the lineage of apostolic succession from the time of Christ's original apostles. As a result, the consecration of bishops without papal consent is considered a grave threat to church unity and a cause of schism, since bishops can ordain new priests. Under church law, a consecration without papal consent incurs an automatic excommunication for the person who celebrates it and the purported new bishop.
