The stormwater discharge will be from construction of the water treatment plant project in Hinton, Iowa. Work associated with the project consists of the following:

- Site grading and paving for the water treatment plant and access road
- Installation of site utilities
- Construction of new Well No. 7
- Construction of new Water Treatment Plant structure
- Installation of equipment, process piping, electrical, mechanical, plumbing, and controls
- Demo of Well No.4.

The Iowa Farm Act is a first-of-its-kind, comprehensive legislative package introduced by Secretary Naig. The bill reflects priorities identified by farmers, agribusinesses, and stakeholders and delivers practical solutions to today's challenges while preparing for the future. The legislation expands economic opportunities by supporting value-added agriculture, agritourism, and new market access. It also provides targeted tax relief and regulatory clarity to reduce costs, promote fairness, and support farm succession. The package invests in the next generation of agriculture by prioritizing beginning farmers and strengthening the rural veterinary workforce. Additionally, it enhances Iowa's biosecurity and foreign animal disease preparedness while protecting farmer confidentiality during emergencies. Finally, the Iowa Farm Act modernizes state operations and improves efficiency to better serve farmers, agribusinesses, and rural communities.
