**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OFFICE, CARROLL, IOWA
MONDAY, JANUARY 26, 2026**

The Board of Supervisors of Carroll County, Iowa met in regular adjourned session in the Boardroom of the Courthouse, in Carroll, Iowa, the County seat of said County on Monday, January 26, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. Central Standard Time pursuant to law, the rules of said Board and to the adjournment with all members present: Scott Johnson, District 1; Mike Andersen, District 2; Eugene Meiners, District 3; Stephanie Hausman, District 4; and Mark McCrea, District 5.

Motion by Hausman, second by Johnson to approve the agenda as presented. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion by Johnson, second by Hausman to approve the minutes of the January 19, 2026, meeting as written. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion by Johnson, second by Andersen to approve the minutes of the January 20, 2026, meeting as written. On roll call, all voted aye.

Josh Axman from Mid Iowa Insurance presented the county property and liability insurance renewal with ICAP (Iowa Communities Assurance Pool) for 2026. Motion by Andersen, second by McCrea to accept the renewal using actual cash value rather than replacement cost. On roll call, all voted aye.

County Engineer Zac Andersen presented three concrete breaker quotes. The Haley Equipment quote was \$16,912.80, Van Wall was \$12,900, and Rueter's was \$14,900. Following discussion, motion by Johnson, second by McCrea to accept the quote from Rueter's per the Engineer's recommendation. On roll call, all voted aye. Andersen updated the Board on limestone quotes. The Board discussed issues on 140th Street. The roads department recently ran a magnet on a portion of 140th Street that has received some complaints. There was a large amount of metal collected, and the Board instructed the roads department to run an additional mile for comparison.

Chair opened a public hearing for a FY26 budget amendment at 9:32 a.m. County Auditor reviewed amended revenues and amended expenditures. Following discussion and hearing no comments from the public, the Chair closed the public hearing at 9:34 a.m.

Motion by Johnson, second by Hausman to approve an appropriations resolution to appropriate the funds for amended expenditures. On a roll call vote, Andersen, aye; Hausman, aye; Meiners, aye; Johnson, aye; and McCrea, aye. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johnson, second by McCrea to adopt Resolution 2026-002 Appointment of Deputy Recorder. On a roll call vote, Andersen, aye; Hausman, aye; Meiners, aye; Johnson, aye; and McCrea, aye. Motion carried unanimously. (Resolution of file in the Auditor's office).

Motion by Johnson, second by Hausman to approve payment of payables as presented. On roll call, all voted aye.

Motion by Johnson, second by McCrea to approve plats of survey on Lot A of Lot 1 NW Fri. 1/4 NW Fri. 1/4 and Lot 1 NE Fri. 1/4 NW Fri. 1/4 Section 6-84-35 and Lot 3 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12-83-33. On roll call, all voted aye.

Clark Nelson, Wellmark Blue Cross Blue Shield Account Manager, reviewed county data for claims and pharmacy reports. Nelson discussed renewal rates for the county's health insurance. He explained initial rates indicate no increase. The final rates for FY27 will be available in late April. The Board will follow Nelson's recommendation on rebate credits.

Wendy Johnson, Carroll Library Director, Linda Muhlbauer, Manning Library Director, and Maura Marsh, Coon Rapids Library Director requested \$88,354 in funding for FY27. An increase of \$4,206 from FY26. The funding is split as follows: Carroll requested \$42,103 and the remaining 3 libraries requested \$15,417 each.

The Board discussed the County Employee Handbook and adding a policy on employee evaluations. No formal action taken.

Motion by Hausman, second by Andersen to add Committee Reports to the agenda. On roll call, all voted aye.

Hausman reported on Board of Supervisor meetings and Conference Board meeting. Upcoming meetings include ISAC Supervisor and Wesco Board.

Meiners reported on Board of Supervisor meetings, Carroll County Growth Partnership Board meeting, Conference Board meeting, ISAC webinar, calls received, and Legislative Forum. Upcoming meetings include Policy Council, Open Meetings, ISAC Supervisor, New Opportunities, and DMACC tour.

Johnson reported on Board of Supervisor meetings, Carroll County Growth Partnership Board, Corks and Conversations at Winery, review payables, 140th Street issues, County wall map, Conference Board meeting, heating issues on 2nd floor of Courthouse, Legislative Forum, deputy ride along, Level C gates on Voyager, and discussions with jail staff.

McCrea reported on Emergency Management Board meeting, Conference Board meeting, OPIOID speaker meeting, and Legislative Forum. Upcoming meetings include Open Meetings, ISAC Supervisor and radio/newspaper interviews.

Andersen reported on Board of Supervisor meetings, Board of Health meeting, Conference Board meeting, 140th Street issues, and Voyager Road. Upcoming Open Meetings training.

Motion by Andersen, second by McCrea to adjourn at 10:46 a.m. On roll call, all voted aye.
